Count On to Add

Another Look! Count on to find the sum.

Add 1 and the sum is 1 more.



3, 4

$$3 + 1 = 4$$

Add 2 and the sum is 2 more.



3, 4, 5

$$3 + 2 = \underline{5}$$

Add 3 and the sum is 3 more.



3, 4, 5, 6

$$3 + 3 = \underline{6}$$

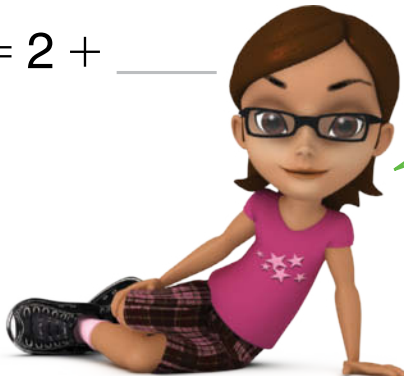
